MAIN PURPOSE OF THE ROLE:	<ul> <li>This training opportunity offers the chance to gain valuable hands-on experience with Torbay Coast and Countryside Trust's Team at Berry Head National Nature Reserve &amp; Site of Special Scientific Interest.</li> <li>To enhance an internationally acclaimed heritage site, with rare and endangered species, and historical monuments.</li> <li>To conserve and enhance the natural beauty, wildlife value and public amenity of Berry Head National Nature Reserve and Site of Special Scientific Interest</li> <li>To improve access to Torbay's coast and countryside and provide facilities for informal outdoor recreation.</li> <li>To conserve wildlife habitats, natural resources and features of archaeological and historic interest.</li> <li>To increase public awareness, understanding and enjoyment of the natural environment of Berry Head and associated sites.</li> <li>To balance the needs of farming, recreation, tourism and conservation in the countryside.</li> <li>To assist in the maintenance of land managed by Torbay Coast and Countryside Trust effectively and in accordance with the overall aims of the Trust.</li> </ul>		
MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:	The above overall aims will be carried out in line with Trust policies. The general duties and responsibilities involved in this work will be as follows:

<ol><li>Performing practical landscape, access and habitat enhancement work to a high standard as directed by the Countryside Manager.</li></ol>
3. Monitoring and surveying species on site.
<ol> <li>Assisting in the management of conservation areas and other land in the best interests of the Trust.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>Working with volunteers, both from organised groups and individuals to carry out a wide range of tasks.</li> </ol>
<ol><li>Improving footpath signing and maintaining existing signs throughout the area.</li></ol>
<ol> <li>Initially providing support to staff leading guided walks and events and eventually leading with support.</li> </ol>
<ol><li>Patrolling and inspecting sites, assisting and advising the public and presenting a positive, helpful image at all times.</li></ol>
<ol> <li>Dealing with conflicts and solving typical problems encountered in urban fringe and coastal areas including fly-tipping, dog fouling, vandalism, off-road biking and trespass.</li> </ol>
